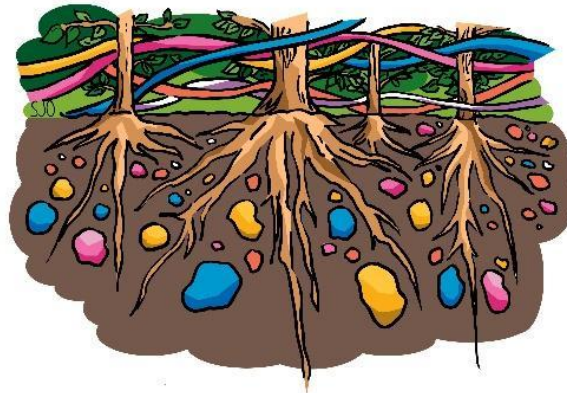


Community Engagement for Equitable Systems Change

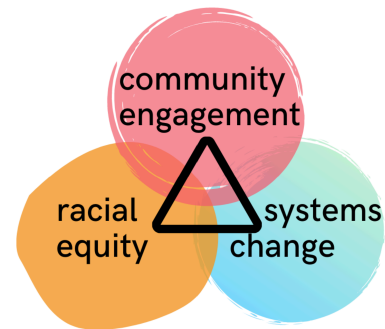
Tools & frameworks to support systems change agents
