How to Increase Participation Through Increased Engagement

VENUE	ENGAGEMENT
Conferences	 Have longer breaks to encourage informal interaction After a keynote speech, have participants discuss in small groups Experiment with Open Space format for gatherings (see https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Open_Space_Technology)
Webinars	 Use videoconferencing formats such as zoom.us that allow public and private chat Use breakout rooms for small group discussion and have people take notes in google docs
Convenings/ meetings	 Involve a small group in developing agendas Have small groups meet to work on action items
Website	 Convert website to blog so people can engage in dialog in comments (or have multiple bloggers) Use Facebook groups to enable discussion
Email	 Seed email list with questions for discussion Make sure email newsletters send participants to discussion sites
Surveys	 Send members or participants links to websurvey such as Survey Monkey or google forms to ask about interests or willingness to work on specific projects Use surveys during webinars
Reports	 Use platforms such as Google docs and wikis to enable participants to edit and provide comments Have <i>zoom.us</i> calls to discuss reports with larger group
